



In Nun's Cross we are constantly looking for ways in which we can incipal improve the education we deliver to our students. Our focus for this current cycle of school self-evaluation will be on the area of spellings, particularly spellings in our written work. This has been highlighted by standardised spelling tests, teacher and parent observation of children's

written work and a lack of desire to write (full sentences, paragraphs and stories) among the pupils. We will be monitoring our progress with spelling in particular, from this current year to 2026. This year our focus will be placed on the individualised spelling progress made through Spellings for Me (2nd - 6th class), phonological awareness in the junior classes, spelling stations in-class with the support of the Special Education Teacher and ensuring complementary phonics programmes being taught in each class. We will keep you all informed of our progress as the year unfolds.
