## **Book Scheme**

For the coming school year, and following the guidelines from the Department, there will be no monetary charge to parents or need for parents to cover the cost of any books, workbooks, copies, folders, readers, homework journals, maths equipment, novels, dictionaries, atlases etc. for any of the children. The cost for all the above, along with various subscriptions to teaching and learning websites and programmes, will be covered under the book scheme grant provided by the department. A copy of our Book Scheme policy is available from the office.

As specified in the guidance from the Department and following a financial review, it is not possible for additional costs to be absorbed by the grant at this time. Therefore, the following items are **not included**:

- Stationery for 1st-6th (each child will need their own pencil case with general stationery supplies)
- arts and crafts supplies for the year €20
- Annual photocopying fee €10
- Music Generation fee €20
- -Pupil protector insurance €8

An invoice for the above fees will be issued in September.

We would like to extend a huge thank you to the amazing team of library volunteers who run our



We are delighted to be able to share the news of our school extension. After months and months of hard work in the background and liaising with architects and the Department of Education, we have finally received the go-ahead on our plans to build our 8<sup>th</sup> classroom and a specialised class to cater for children with additional needs. The plans for the proposed build will be on display for the school community to view at our Family day. Please be aware that these plans may still change as we now need to seek planning permission from the local authorities.



In addition to this news, we are absolutely delighted to inform you that we have secured additional play space at the rear of the school. This space will more than replace the small amount of space being lost by our build and we are delighted for its addition to our school. This space has been very kindly gifted to the school by the landowner and we are extremely grateful for his generosity. While we have been very busy planning, sketching
